# Justice Ramana appointed as next CJI, to take oath on Apr 24

**SENIOR-MOST SUPREME COURT** Justice Nuthalapati Venkata Ramana was on Tuesday appointed as the next Chief Justice of India.

According to a notification issued by the government, Justice Ramana would take over as the 48th CJI on April 24 after incumbent CJI SA Bobde demits office a day before.

Justice Ramana would retire on August 26, 2022.

"In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 124 of the Constitution of India, the President is pleased to appoint Shri Justice Nuthalapati Venkata Ramana, Judge of the Supreme Court, to be the Chief Justice of India with effect from 24th April, 2021," the notification read.

As per convention, Principal Secretary to the prime minister PK Mishra and Secretary (Justice) in the law ministry Barun Mitra handed over the warrant of appointment signed by the President to Justice Ramana this morning, sources said.

Justice Bobde had recently recommended Justice Ramana as his successor in keeping with convention and norms of seniority.

The CJI's recommendation to the union government had come on a day when the Supreme Court had made public its decision to dismiss a complaint of Andhra Pradesh chief minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy against Justice Ramana after giving the matter "due consideration".

He was part of a five-judge constitution bench which had in November 2019 held that office of the CJI is a public authority under the Right to Information Act.

In the November 2019 verdict, the top court had also said that "judicial independence should be kept in mind" while disclosing information in "public interest".

In another important verdict, Justice Ramana-led bench had in January last year held that freedom of speech and conducting business on the Internet are protected under the Constitution and had directed the Jammu and Kashmir administration to immediately review curb orders.

The bench had directed the authorities in the Union Territory to immediately review all orders suspending Internet services and said orders not in accordance with the law must be revoked.

He was also a part of a five-judge constitution bench of the top court which had in a landmark verdict in 2016 ordered restoration of the Congress government in Arunachal Pradesh, saying the "clock should be turned back", as it quashed all decisions of the Governor that precipitated its fall in January, holding them "violative" of the Constitution.

In November 2019, a bench led by Justice Ramana had ordered floor test for then Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis to prove his majority in the House saying there is a "possibility of horse trading" in case of delay.

As per norms, a written communication from the incumbent Chief Justice is sent a month before his retirement. Born on August 27, 1957 in Ponnavaaram village of Andhra Pradesh's Krishna district, Justice Ramana was enrolled as an advocate on February 10, 1983.

He was appointed as a permanent judge of the Andhra Pradesh High Court on June 27, 2000 and functioned as acting Chief Justice of the Andhra Pradesh High Court from March 10, 2013 to May 20, 2013.

Justice Ramana was elevated as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court on September 2, 2013 and was appointed as a Judge of the Supreme Court on February 17, 2014.

Justice Ramana has dealt with several high-profile cases in the apex court.

A five-judge constitution bench headed by Justice Ramana had in March last year declined to refer to a larger seven-judge bench a batch of pleas challenging the constitutional validity of the Centre's decision to abrogate provisions of Article 370.

# SC Collegium approves 10 names as permanent judges of Bombay HC

**THE SUPREME COURT** Collegium has approved the proposal for appointment of 10 Additional Judges of Bombay High Court as Permanent Judges.

The judges whose appointment has been recommended include Justices Avinash Gunwant Gharote, Nitin Bhawantrao Suryawanshi, Anil Satyavijay Kilor, Milind Narendra Jadhav, MG Sewlikar, VG

Bisht, Debadwar Bhalchandra Ugrasen, MS Jawalkar, SP Tavade and NR Borkar.

The Collegium in a meeting on April 5, 2021 also approved the proposal for appointment of five Additional Judges of Kerala High Court as Permanent Judges.

The names include Justices Conrad S Dias, PV Kunhikrishnan, TR Ravi, Bechu Kurian Thomas and Gopinath P.

Justice Vinla Singh Kapoor, Additional Judge of Chhattisgarh High Court as Permanent Judge of that High Court.

The Collegium headed by Chief Justice SA Bobde in a meeting held on Monday approved the proposals which was uploaded on the apex court website on Tuesday.

Besides Bobde, Justices N V Ramana and R F Nariman are part of the three-member Collegium which takes decision with regard to the high court judges.

# Maha govt, Deshmukh move SC against HC order on CBI probe

**THE MAHARASHTRA GOVERNMENT** and its former home minister Anil Deshmukh moved the Supreme Court on Tuesday challenging the Bombay High Court order directing a CBI probe against him and raised questions over the integrity of the central probe agency and impact on the country's federal structure.

Maharashtra questioned the procedure adopted by the high court saying that the state was heard on the question of maintainability of the pleas seeking CBI investigation against Deshmukh on the allegation of corruption, and the order too was reserved on that issue, but the court finally ended up directing the probe.

After the high court order on Monday, Deshmukh, a veteran politician from Vidarbha, resigned from the state government. In his appeal, Deshmukh said the high court order raises issues of seminal importance which "impact not just the federal structure of

the country, impact on our polity, but also the manner in which, and the institutions through which investigations are to be conducted".

Last but not the least, is the interpretation of a High Court of its extensive powers under article 226 of the Constitution in terms of which the entire state machinery has been supplanted as if no investigation in the state can ever serve the cause of justice, and that an agency of the central government wherein its directors reputation in the past have not been above board, have now been charged with a responsibility of conducting a preliminary enquiry..., the plea said.

# Average spot power price soars 65% to ₹4.06 per unit at IEX

**AVERAGE SPOT POWER** price rose by 65% to ₹4.06 per unit in March compared to the year-ago month at Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) mainly due to increase in demand on account of rise in temperature and revival of economic activities.

"The day-ahead market (DAM) traded 6,549 MU (million units) volume recording a significant 65% YoY (year on year) growth. The average

monthly price at ₹4.06 per unit during the month saw a 20% MoM (month on month) increase," an IEX statement said.

According to IEX data, average spot power price in DAM was ₹2.46 per unit in March 2020 and ₹3.39 per unit in February 2021.

The IEX explained that the increase in price was mainly due to the increase in demand for electricity during the month due to sharp rise in temperature, revival of economic and commercial activities.

# सेबी के चेयरमैन अजय त्यागी ने सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों से कहा चेयरमैन और प्रबंध निदेशक की भूमिका अलग करें

नई दिल्ली, 6 अप्रैल (भाषा)।

भारतीय प्रतिभूति व विनियम बोर्ड (सेबी) ने सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों से कहा कि वे अप्रैल, 2022 की समयसीमा से पहले चेयरमैन और प्रबंध निदेशकों की भूमिका को अलग करने के लिए काम करें। नियामक ने स्पष्ट किया है कि नए निदेशक का मकसद प्रवर्तकों की स्थिति को कमजोर करना नहीं है।

सेबी ने जनवरी, 2020 में सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों के लिए चेयरमैन और प्रबंध निदेशकों (एमडी) की भूमिका को विभाजित करने की व्यवस्था को प्रवर्तकों को अलग पर दो साल के लिए टाल दिया था। बाजार पूंजीकरण के लिहाज से शीर्ष 500 सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों के लिए ये नियमन अब एक अप्रैल, 2022 से लागू होंगे। सेबी के चेयरमैन अजय त्यागी ने

मंगलवार को कहा कि इस नई व्यवस्था से सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों के संचालन ढांचे में सुधार लाने में मदद मिलेगी। त्यागी ने भारतीय उद्योग परिषद (सीआइआई) के कॉरपोरेट गवर्नेंस पर आयोजित वरुंडल कार्यक्रम को संबोधित करते हुए कहा कि इससे किसी एक व्यक्ति के पास अधिक अधिकारों को कम करने में मदद मिलेगी।

उन्होंने कहा कि दिसंबर, 2020 तक शीर्ष 500 सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों में से करीब 53 फीसद इस नियामकीय प्रावधान का अनुपालन कर रही थीं। त्यागी ने कहा, 'मैं पात्र सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों से कहूंगा कि इस बदलाव के लिए समयसीमा से पहले ही तैयार हो जाएं।' त्यागी ने कहा कि इस विभाजन के पीछे विचार प्रवर्तकों की स्थिति को कमजोर करने का नहीं है बल्कि हम कामकाज

सेबी नियमों के तहत शीर्ष 500 सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों को एक अप्रैल, 2020 से चेयरपर्सन और प्रबंध निदेशक या मुख्य कार्यपालक अधिकारी (सीईओ) की भूमिका को विभाजित करना था। कई कंपनियों ने चेयरमैन और प्रबंध निदेशक का पद मिला दिया है। इससे हितों के टकराव की स्थिति पैदा हो सकती है। इसी के मद्देनजर नियामक ने मई, 2018 में इन पदों को विभाजित करने के नियम पेश किए थे।

ये नियम सेबी द्वारा कॉरपोरेट गवर्नेंस पर नियुक्त कोटक समिति की सिफारिशों का हिस्सा हैं। सेबी प्रमुख ने कहा कि वैश्विक स्तर पर भी अब चेयरपर्सन और एमडी/सीईओ के पदों को विभाजित करने पर काम हो रहा है। ब्रिटेन और आस्ट्रेलिया में बहस अब दोनों पदों को विभाजित करने की ओर झुक गई है। जर्मनी और नीदरलैंड में दो स्तरीय बोर्डों का है। इससे बोर्ड और प्रबंधन की भूमिका अलग-अलग हो जाती है। त्यागी ने कहा कि कोविड-19 के दौरान सूचीबद्ध कंपनियों को सभी अंशधारकों से पर्याप्त जानकारी मिलनी चाहिए। उन्होंने कहा कि कंपनियों को यह बताना चाहिए कि महामारी का क्या वित्तीय प्रभाव हुआ है। उन्हें सिर्फ चुनिंदा खुलासे तक सीमित नहीं रहना चाहिए।

# शेयर बाजार मामूली बढ़त के साथ बंद, मौद्रिक नीति पर नजर

मुंबई, 6 अप्रैल (भाषा)।

शेयर बाजारों में मंगलवार को उतार-चढ़ाव भरें कारोबार में मामूली बढ़त रही। देश में कारोना संक्रमितों की संख्या फिर तेजी से बढ़ने और उसका अर्थव्यवस्था पर पड़ने वाले प्रभाव को लेकर चिंता के बीच बाजार में उतार-चढ़ाव रहा। कारोबारियों के अनुसार बुधवार को जारी होने वाली मौद्रिक नीति समीक्षा पर निवेशकों की नजर है। इससे उमंगें से कई बाजार से दूर रहे।

बंबई शेयर बाजार के तीस शेयरों पर आधारित सूचकांक में कारोबार के दौरान करीब 646 अंकों का उतार-चढ़ाव आया। अंत में यह पिछले दिन के बंद के मुकाबले 42.07 अंक यानी 0.09 फीसद की मामूली बढ़त के साथ 49,201.39 अंक पर बंद हुआ। इसी प्रकार, नेशनल स्टॉक एक्सचेंज का निफ्टी 45.70 अंक यानी 0.31 फीसद की हल्की बढ़त के साथ 14,683.50 अंक पर बंद हुआ। सूचकांक में शामिल शेयरों में सर्वाधिक लाभ में एशियन पेंट्स रहा। इसमें 4.07 फीसद की तेजी आई। इसके अलावा सन फार्मा, एचयूएल, एचडीएफसी, डा. रेड्डीज, नेस्ले इंडिया और महिंद्रा एंड महिंद्रा में भी अच्छी तेजी रही। दूसरी तरफ, जिन शेयरों में गिरावट दर्ज की गई, उमंगें पावरग्रिड, एक्सिस बैंक, इंडस्ट्रियल बैंक, अल्ट्राटेक सीमेंट और आइसीआइसीआई बैंक शामिल हैं। इनमें 2.29 फीसद तक की गिरावट दर्ज की गई।

रिलायंस सिन्योरिटीज के रणनीतिक मामलों के प्रमुख विनोद मोदी ने कहा कि घरेलू शेयर बाजारों में काफी उतार-चढ़ाव रहा और शुरू में जो अच्छी तेजी थी, वह कायम नहीं रह पाई। इसका कारण देश भर में कारोना मामलों में तेजी और उसके कारण विभिन्न राश्यों में लगाई गई राई पारिवर्तियों से निवेशकों की धारणा पर असर पड़ना है। उन्होंने कहा, 'मेरे विचार से जब तक कारोना विषाणु को फैलने से रोका नहीं जाता या उस पर काबू नहीं पाया जाता, निफ्टे भविष्य में बाजार में उतार-चढ़ाव बना रह सकता है। महाराष्ट्र का देश के सकल घरेलू उत्पाद (जीडीपी) में 13 फीसद से अधिक और औद्योगिक उत्पादन में करीब 20 फीसद का योगदान है। ऐसे में वहां सप्ताहांत पूर्णबंदी से निश्चित रूप से अर्थव्यवस्था पर अच्छा प्रभाव नहीं पड़ेगा।'
